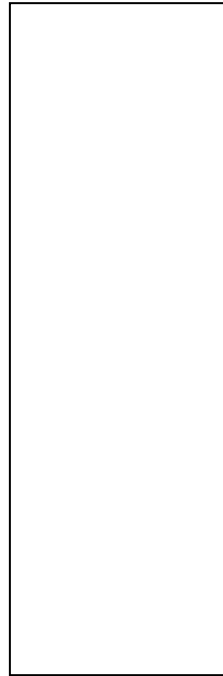

Grounds: Located at the BLM Las Cienegas Resource Area – Approximately 27 miles south of I-10 and 4 miles east of Highway 83 (entrance off Highway 82) near Sonoita, AZ – see directions below.

Lodging: The nearest lodging is in Sonoita, at the Sonoita Inn, 520-455-5935, but availability of rooms is limited. The Stage Stop Inn in Patagonia, AZ is also nearby – 520-394-2211.

Camping: Will be permitted on the grounds. BLM requests that we keep our vehicles and trailers in the designated area and that we haul out all our own trash. There will be Porta-Johns on site. Water will be available for horses and dogs, but bring water for yourselves as no drinking water is available. BLM also requests that we fill in any holes dug by dogs and rake horse tie-out areas at the end of the event.

Dog Wagon: We will have dog wagons to bring dogs to the line. Handlers, PLEASE fully identify each dog so that the driver doesn't have to guess!

Cocktail Hour: We will have a cocktail party Saturday evening following the day's running. Club members are asked to bring an appetizer.

Water & Trash: We will once again have a water truck onsite. We are asking for a minimum donation of \$10.00 per rig for anyone wishing to use this water. This is strictly a voluntary fee but we ask you to consider the cost to the club and do the right thing to help out. You can include the fee with your entry fees or give it to the FT secretary during the trial. The BLM is asking us this year to bag and dispose of horse manure, excess straw, etc. The club will provide a dumpster for this purpose.

Parking: Designated parking areas will be marked and no overnight parking will be allowed outside the designated areas.

DIRECTIONS: The site for the trial is "Road Canyon" which is located in the south central area of Las Cienegas NCA.

Travel SOUTH on Hwy 83 to Sonoita and then turn EAST on HWY 82. Approx 3.8 miles east of Sonoita is the SOUTH entrance to Las Cienegas, turn NORTH and travel for about 3 miles to the site. (You should be able to see vehicles at the site from Hwy 82 as you approach the turn.)
